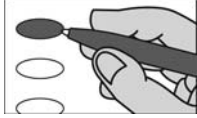


INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER:
